

ORDINANCE NO. 1

An Act defining misdemeanors and providing penalties for the commission thereof.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton, Carlton County, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1
LURKING
BURNING
PROVINE

Any person who shall be found lurking or concealed in any house, barn, store warehouse, shed or other building or in any private yard, alley, lane or enclosure or in any of the streets, alleys, parks or public places of said Village, with intent to pilfer, or steal or commit an assault or to commit any crime or public offence, contrary to law shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

RIOT

Any person who shall make or aid in making or in any manner assist in making or cause or induce any other person or persons to make or aid in making any loud noise or riot, or public disturbance or any breach of the peace, or any vulgar or obscene or unlawful diversion, within the corporate limits of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 3
RIOTS

All persons who shall collect together in bodies or crowds, within the corporate limits of said Village, for the purpose of creating a riot, or public disturbance, or breach of the peace, or to annoy any Citizen of Citizens, of said Village, or to disturb any citizen or person in said Village, or to destroy or injure any private or public property, or for any other unlawful purpose, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

REFUSING
TO
DISBURSE

Each and every person so collected together as stated in section three of this ordinance, who shall neglect or refuse to disburse upon being notified so to do, by the Magistrate or Peace Officer of said Village or Magistrate or Peace Officer of said County of Carlton or State of Minnesota, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

FIGHTING

Any person who shall engage in any fighting, or noisy altercation or shall make any assault or assault and battery upon the person of another within the corporate limits of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 6
FIGHTING

Any person who shall aid, assist, induce or procure another to make an assault or assault and battery or to engage in any fighting within the corporate limits of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

INTOXICATED

Any person who shall be found intoxicated in any street, lane, alley, park or public place of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

FIREARMS

Any person who shall discharge any gun, pistol, revolver or any firearms within the corporate limits of said Village shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 9
DISURBANCE

Any person who shall create or who shall induce, procure, aid or assist another to create any undue noise or disturbance, in or about any lawful public meeting or religious assemblage, or shall in any manner disturb or annoy any lawful public meeting or religious assemblage within the corporate limits of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

INDUCEMENT
EXPOSURE

Any person who shall appear in any street, lane, alley, park or public place of said Village in a state of nudity, (or in the clothing of habiliments of the opposite sex) or in any indecent or leud dress or who shall make indecent or leud exposure of his or her person, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

OBSCEENITY

Any person who shall use any vile, obscence, vulgar or profane language, or swearing in the streets, lanes , alleys, parks or Public places of said Village, or in any Hall, Church, School-house or other public building of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

ANIMAL ABUSE

Any person who shall within the corporate limits of said Village wantonly or cruelly, beat, abuse or torture any dumb animal or expose such animal to the severities of the weather without proper shelter, or any owner of such animal who shall neglect or refuse to properly feed and care for the same shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

OPEN EXCAVATION

Any person who shall make and leave open without a sufficient guard any cellar, cistern, vault, well or other excavation within the Corporate limits of said Village shall be guilty of a misdeamor.

DEFACING PUBLIC PROPERTY

Any person who shall mar, or mutillate or injure any public building or other public property within the corporate limits of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

HOUSES OF PROSTITUTION

Any person who shall keep any House of Ill Fame resorted to for the purpose of prostitution, within the corporate limits of said Village or who shall be the proprietor of or engage in carrying on or operating any such house of ill fame or house of prostitution within the corporate limits of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

PROSTITUTES

Any person who shall be found residing in a house of ill fame resorted to for the purpose of prostitution, within the corporate limits of said Village shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

USE OF PROSTITUTES

Any person who shall be found visiting any house of ill fame resorted to fro the purpose of prostitution, within the corporate limits of said Village shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

PROPRIETOR OF A HOUSE OF PROSTITUTION

Any person who is Agent or Owner lets or demises any building or any portion of any building to be used as such a house of Ill Fame or knowing that it is to be used as such house of Ill Fame or who permits any building or any portion of any building to be used as such house of ill fame within the Corporate Limits of said Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

VICIOUS ANIMALS

Any person the owner of or the keeper of any vicious animal who shall allow the same to be at large within the corporate limits of said Village shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. In actions under this section it shall only be necessary to prove the fact of viciousness of such animal and it shall not be necessary to prove the knowledge of such viciousness by the owner of such animal.

Sec. 20

CONCEALED WEAPONS

Any person who shall be found carrying a revolver, knife, pistol or any other weapon concealed about his person, within the corporate limits of said Village except such person be an officer, authorized to carry such weapon, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

In actions under this section it shall be necessary to prove only the carrying of the weapon concealed by the person.

PROOF OF PROSTITUTION

In actions under sections 15, 16, and 17 and 18 of this ordinance it shall be necessary to prove such facts and circumstances as would naturally lead a resonably prudent man to believe the fact alleged in the complaint and warrant.

PENALTY

All person convicted of any misdemeanor as above defined, or who shall be convicted of the violation of any section or provision of this ordinance, before any Justice of the Peace in and for the said Village, shall be fined in a sum not less than One Dollar nor more than One Hundred dollars and costs of suit, and in default of payment of said fine and costs, the person so convicted shall be committed to the Watch house or Jail of said Village or County Jail of said County until such fine and costs are fully paid, but not to exceed ninety days.

Sec. 23

Old ordinance number three entitled "An ordinance relating to good order and the Public Peace is hereby repealed, also Old ordinance number Four entitled "An ordinance to suppress Prostitution and Keeping houses of ill fame" is hereby repealed.

Sec. 24

This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
