

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ACT DEFINING DISORDERLY PERSONS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES TO BE IMPOSED UPON CONVICTION THEREOF WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

*MAD D.P.*  
*DISORDERLY PERSONS (NO SUPPORT)*  
Sec. 1 Any person found within the Corporate Limits of said Village of Carlton, (with no visible means of support) shall be deemed a disorderly persons.

*MAD D.P. (IDLY LIVING)*  
Sec. 2 Any person who shall be found (living idly without employment or without any legitimate business) within the Corporate Limits of said Village shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*LOITERING*  
Sec. 3 Any person who shall be found within the Corporate Limits of said Village (without any settled place of abode or loitering about saloons, bawdy houses, houses of ill fame, or loitering about the streets, lanes, alleys, parks or public places of said Village) without occupation shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*PUBLIC TRESPASSING*  
Sec. 4 Any person found trespassing in any School house or Church or other public building within the Corporate Limits of said Village or trespassing on the grounds of yards of such School house or Church or public building, shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*PRIVATE TRESPASSING*  
Sec. 5 Any person found trespassing on any private premises or in any private house within the Corporate Limits of said Village shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*DISURBING THE PEACE*  
Sec. 6 Any person who shall either in the night time or the day time within the Corporate Limits of said Village disturb any resident of said Village by shouting or hollering around a private house or by prowling around such house or by making any un-called for noise, around such house shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*BEGGING*  
Sec. 7 Any person found begging or soliciting alms within the Corporate Limits of said Village shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*FORTUNE TELLING*  
Sec. 8 All person found within the Corporate Limits of said Village telling fortunes for money, or for anything of value, and all persons who shall be found going about said Village pretending to tell fortunes for money or for anything of value, shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*CARD GAMES*  
Sec. 9 Any person found within the Corporate Limits of said Village gambling with cards for money or its equivalent, or found dealing cards at the game called "Faro" "Pharo" or "Forty-eight" or "Poker" or any other game whether the game so dealt with fifty-two cards or any other number of cards for money or its equivalent shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*CARD GAMES DEVICES*  
Sec. 10 Any person found within the Corporate Limits of the said Village keeping any gambling device whatever designed to be used in gambling shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*UNDUE NOISE*  
Sec. 11 Any person who shall in any of the streets, lanes, alleys, parks or public places of said Village make any undue noise or halloing shall be deemed a disorderly person.

*MAD*  
*ILLEGAL SCHEMES*  
Sec. 12 Any person who shall be found within the Corporate Limits of said Village exhibiting any trick or device or a scheme to cheat people out of their money or to cheat people out of anything of value, or any person found within said Village attempting to cheat people out of their money or other thing of value by means of any trick or device or scheme shall be deemed a disorderly person.

FAMILY  
NEGLECT

All person within the corporate limits of said Village who shall refuse to support their families or neglect to do so, and leave wives and children a burden on the public, such persons being of sufficient ability to support their families, shall be deemed disorderly persons.

PROOF

In all actions under this ordinance, it shall be necessary to prove only such facts as would naturally lead a reasonably prudent man to believe the allegations of the complaint and warrant.

PENALTY

Any person convicted of being a disorderly person as above defined, or convicted of the violation of any provision of this ordinance before any Justice of the Peace in and for said Village, shall be fined in the sum of not less than One Dollar, nor more than One Hundred Dollars, together with costs of suit and in case of default of payment of said fine and costs, the person so convicted shall be committed to the Watch house or Jail of said Village or County Jail of said County until such fine and costs are fully paid, but not to exceed ninety days. Provided, said Justice may suspend sentence in any of the above cases, whenever he shall deem it to be for the best interest of the Village so to do.

Old ordinance number Eight (8) entitled "An ordinance relating to Vagrants" is hereby repealed.

Sec. 17

This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
