

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ACT DEFINING NUISANCES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE COMMISSION THEREOF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

MAINTAINING NUISANCE
Sec. 1 It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, company or corporation to commit either directly or indirectly or to maintain either directly or indirectly, any nuisance within the corporate limits of said Village.

LEGAL OBSTRUCTION
Sec. 2 The unlawful doing of any act, or the unlawful omission to perform any duty which act or omission first: annoys, injures, or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety of any considerable number of persons or, second: offends public decency, or third: unlawfully interferes with, obstructs or tends to obstruct or renders dangerous for passage any public street, lane, alley, park or thoroughfare of said Village, or fourth: in any way renders a considerable number of persons insecure in life or the use of property, is hereby made a nuisance.

ANIMAL REFUSE
Sec. 3 The killing, butchering or slaughtering of any dumb animal within the Corporate limits of said Village, excepting same be done by a public officer in the performance of his duties, is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

DEPOSITING UNCLE TOM'S CABIN
Sec. 4 The depositing or leaving within the corporate limits of said Village in any street, lane, alley, park or public place or upon any lot, any dead animal, carcass of any dead animal or any part of any carcass of any dead animal or any refuse or any vegetable matter liable to decay, or any unwholesome substance, is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

UNATTENDED CORPSE
Sec. 5 Any person the owner or occupant of any lands within said Village, or the owner or occupant of any building within said Village, who shall allow the putrid carcass of any dead animal or any part of any such carcass or any decaying vegetable matter, or any unwholesome or offensive substance, to remain on said lands or in said building, after being notified to remove the same by the Village Council of said Village, or the Board of Health of said Village or the Village Marshall of said Village, shall be guilty of maintaining a nuisance.

GORBAGE NEGLIGENCE
Sec. 6 Any person the owner or occupant of any premises within the corporate limits of said Village, who shall neglect or refuse to clean or remove any privy, vault, cesspool or other unwholesome or offensive thing, the same being on said premises, after being notified to do so by the Village Council of said Village or the Board of Health of said Village, or the Village Marshall of said Village, shall be guilty of maintaining a nuisance.

PENALTY
Sec. 7 Any person convicted of the commission of any nuisance or convicted of maintaining any nuisance before any Justice of the Peace in and for said Village shall be fined in a sum of not less than One Dollar nor more than One Hundred dollars, together with costs of suit, and in default of payment of said fine and costs, said person so convicted shall be confined in the Watch house or Jail of said Village or the County Jail of said County until said fine and costs are fully paid, but not to exceed ninety days.

Sec. 8 Old Ordinance Number Twelve entitled "Health Ordinance" is hereby repealed.

Sec. 9 This act shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
