

ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ACT RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GRADE FOR THE STREETS AND SIDEWALKS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, AND PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF CONSTRUCTING THE SAME.

The Village Council of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1           The grade of the streets of the Village of Carlton is hereby established and declared to be such as the Village Council shall determine and direct by order to the Street Commissioner.
- Sec. 2           All sidewalks on South Street, North Street, Chestnut Street, Walnut Street, North 2nd Street, North 3rd Street, North 4th Street and South 2nd Street, South 3rd Street, and South 4th Street in said Village shall be of the uniform width of Eight (8) feet, and shall be constructed of two inch planks, laid upon four stringers of not less demensions than 2 x 6 inches, and securely fastened therto by spâkes, so that the same shall be firm and durable. Said sidewalks shall be so constructed that the top thereof shall be ten inches above the middle of said streets.
- Sec. 3           All sidewalk consutructed on any other street of said Village shall be so built of such material, as the Council from time to time by resolution declare.
- Sec. 4           All sidewalks constructed in said Village and all repairs thereon, shall be subject to the approval of the Street Commissioner.
- Sec. 5           This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
