

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF DRAYS, HACKS, AND EXPRESS WAGONS.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton, do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1           It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or Corporation to engage in the business of draying or carrying persons, parcels or baggage from one part of said Village to another, for hire without first procuring a license therefore, as hereinafter provided, and any person, firm, or Corporation, who shall be convicted of the violation of the provisions of this ordinance before any Justice of the Peace in and for said Village, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten (10) Dollars, nor more than Twenty-five (25) Dollars for every such violation together with the costs of such conviction, and shall be committed to the Village Jail or County Jail of Carlton County, until such fine and costs shall be fully paid, but not to exceed ninety days.
- Sec. 2           Any person, firm or corporation desiring to obtain such license shall make application therefore in writing to the Recorder of said Village, and shall present with such application the receipt of the Village Treasurer for the sume of Five (5) Dollars, for each team to be used in such business and thereupon it shall be the duty of said recorder to issued to such person, firm or corporation a license to carry on such business in said Village, provided that such license shall not be granted for a period longer than one year.
- Sec. 3           The Recorder shall keep a record of all such licenses so granted in the license book provided for that purpose, and all monies so received shall be credited to the General Fund of said Village.
- Sec. 4           This act shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
