

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF RAILWAY LOCOMOTIVES AND TRAINS IN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1           It shall be unlawful for any person, company or corporation operating any railway line in said Village to run its locomotives or trains within or through said Village at a speed greater than six (6) miles per hour.
- Sec. 2           Any person or persons in charge of or in any manner connected with or responsible for the running of such locomotives or trains at a greater speed than six miles as aforesaid, shall upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace in and for said Village, be punished by a ~~fine~~ of not more than (25) Twenty five dollars and the costs of such conviction, and shall be committed to the Village Jail or County Jail of said Carlton County until such fine and costs are fully paid, but not to exceed ten days.
- Sec. 3           This act shall take effect immediately after its passage and publication.
