

CITY OF CARLTON ORDINANCE NUMBER 162

An Ordinance amending City Ordinance Number 86 entitled "An Ordinance regulating the maintenance and use of the Carlton Village Cemetery.

The City Council of the City of Carlton, Minnesota hereby ordains as follows.

Section 2(e) shall be amended to read;

He shall have charge of the digging of all graves in the cemetery; every grave for an adult shall be at least five feet deep, and for a child at least 4 feet deep, and each interment, except for cremations, shall be made within a concrete or otherwise approved grave box or liner, also commonly called a burial vault, which will not deteriorate over time allowing the earth load to cave in.

This Ordinance becomes effective from and after it's passage and publication. Passed by the City Council the 7th day of December, 1993.
