

ORDINANCE NUMBER 157

An Ordinance Amending City Ordinance Number 131, entitled "AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION."

The City Council of the City of Carlton Ordains :

Section 4. - License Fees., Subdivision 1. - Fees, Shall be and hereby is amended to read;

The Annual Fee for an "ON-SALE" Liquor License shall be \$2,000.00. However, \$500.00 of this fee shall be waived if, at the time of license issuance or renewal, the Licensee makes certification to the City on the certification form provided, that the licensee(s) and all current employees of the licensee who serve liquor to patrons of the licensee's business establishment (bartenders/waiters/waitresses) are either certified through the program known as "Techniques of Alcohol Management" (T.A.M.) or have been trained in the responsible service of alcoholic beverages by having viewed the T.A.M. produced training video entitled "Another Friday Night." Further, the licensee shall certify that it shall be a job requirement of all new employees who will or may, as a part of their job duties serve alcoholic beverages to patrons in the establishment of the licensee, that they are either T.A.M. certified or that they will be trained through the viewing of the T.A.M. video, prior to performing any duties in the establishment of the licensee.

In the event that the \$500.00 waiver has been granted to a licensee on the basis of the licensee having submitted the training certification form to the City, and it is later found that the licensee is not, in fact, complying with the waiver stipulations, then the waiver will be revoked and the licensee will be required to pay the additional \$500.00 in order to keep his/her license active for the remainder of the year.

The Annual Fee for an "On-Sale Wine License is \$100.00 and the annual fee for an "Off-Sale" Liquor License is \$100.00.

This Ordinance becomes effective from and after it's passage and publication.
