

ORDINANCE NUMBER 150

An Ordinance Amending Section 4 of Ordinance Number 141 Entitled " An Ordinance Relating To Parking of Motor Vehicles, Boats and Trailers upon City Streets, Alleys and Thoroughfares.

The City Council of the City of Carlton does hereby ordain:

I. Section 4 of Ordinance Number 141 shall be amended to read;

Any property owner lawfully parking a semi-truck, on private property, prior to the Original date of passage of this ordinance (141), which said act becomes unlawful because of rezoning of such property shall be entitled to continue such useage during the period of time such property owner continues to own such property. Abandonment of such useage for a continuous period of one year shall terminate the right of such property owner to thereafter continue such useage.

II. This Ordinance becomes effective upon it's passage and publication, according to law.
