

ORDINANCE NUMBER 148

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 131 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION."**

The City Council of the City of Carlton does hereby ordain as follows:

- I. Ordinance Number 131 - Section 2. License Required, shall be amended to add the authority to issue Sunday-On Sale Licenses, as follows.

Sunday, ON-Sale Licenses shall be issued only in conjunction with the sale of food to restaurants, clubs, bowling centers or hotels with a seating capacity for at least 30 persons and which hold an On-Sale Intoxicating Liquor License, and which meet the qualifications of Minnesota Statute 340A.504 Subd. 3, and any additional or subsequent Minnesota Statutes pertaining thereto.

- II. Ordinance 131 Section 4 License Fees - Subd. 1-Fees shall be amended to include the following.

The Annual Fee for s Sunday On-Sale License shall be \$200.00. In Addition there shall be an Investigative Fee of \$75.00 for the initial license issued to an establishment, and this fee may also be applied to the transfer of an existing license.

- III. This Ordinance becomes effective upon it's passage and publication, according to law.
