

ORDINANCE NUMBER 144

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 99 ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION TO PLAN FOR THE PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE CITY OF CARLTON, MINNESOTA, AND TO RECOMMEND A ZONING PLAN".

The City Council of the City of Carlton does hereby Ordain as follows:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 99 , SECTION II - COMPOSITION, is hereby amended to read as follows.

**Section II - Composition.** Such Planning Commission shall consist of 5 members, which shall constitute the voting body. The members shall be appointed by the City Council and may be removed by a four fifths vote of the Council. The Council may select one member of the Commission from among it's own members including the Mayor.


Terms of office of the members shall be 5 years, except the term of the Mayor or City Council Member on the Commission shall correspond to their respective Official tenure.

Vacancies during a term shall be filled by the Council for the unexpired portion of the term. Every appointed member of the Planning Commission shall take an oath that he will faithfully discharge the duties of his office. All members shall serve without compensation.


**Repeal** - Ordinance Number 130, passed Oct. 7th, 1940 is hereby repealed.
