

ORDINANCE NUMBER 134

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 102 ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, MINNESOTA, IN PURSUANCE OF THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY CHAPTER 670, LAWS OF 1965, MINNESOTA STATUTES, TO PROMOTE THE HEALTH, SAFETY, CONVENIENCE AND WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS BY DIVIDING THE VILLAGE INTO ZONES AND REGULATING THEREIN THE USES OF LAND AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS WITH A VIEW TO ENCOURAGING THE MOST APPROPRIATE USE OF LAND IN THE VILLAGE."

The City Council of the City Of Carlton Does Hereby Ordain As Follows :

Ordinance Number 102-Section I - Official Zoning District Map - is hereby revised as follows :

Lots 1,6,7,8,9 - Block 8 - Woodland Park Addition to the City of Carlton, are hereby rezoned from Manufacturing (M) to Open Space (O).

Ordinance Number 102 Section VIII , page 5 - Classification List , is hereby amended as follows:

The use category " trucking terminal" shall have an open circle placed in the Open Space (O) column, making this use allowable in an Open Space zone by special exception permit.

This Ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication, according to law.
