

ORDINANCE # 130

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 99 ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION TO PLAN FOR THE PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, MINNESOTA, AND TO RECOMMEND A ZONING PLAN"

The City Council of the City of Carlton Does Hereby Ordain as Follows:


Ordinance Number 99 Section II - Composition , is hereby amended as follows.

Such Planning Commission shall consist of 6 members. Five members, which shall constitute the voting body, shall be appointed by the City Council and may be removed by a four fifths vote of the Council. No person who is presently a member of the City Council or the Mayor, may be a member of the voting body of the Planning Commission. The sixth member of the Planning Commission shall be a member of ex-officio and shall be a member of the City Council. The sixth seat may be shared by more than one member of the City Council on a rotating basis.


Terms of Office of the voting members shall be 5 years, with one term expiring each year on a rotating basis. The terms of ex-officio members shall correspond to their respective official tenures. Vacancies during the term shall be filled by the Council for the unexpired portion of the term. Every appointed member before entering upon the discharge of his duties shall take an oath that he will faithfully discharge the duties of his office. All members shall serve without compensation.

This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
