

ORDINANCE NUMBER 128

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CARLTON, MINNESOTA, ESTABLISHING A SHADE TREE PROGRAM, PROVIDING REGULATION FOR THE CONTROL OF CERTAIN DISEASES AFFECTING TREES, INCORPORATING AGENCY RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

The City Council of the City of Carlton, Minnesota Ordains as follows:

Section I. Regulations Adopted By Reference. Sections 1.0109 through 1.0111 of Minnesota Code of Agency Rules, Dept. of Agriculture, Shade Tree Program (1978 Edition) together with amendments thereof to date, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this Ordinance as if set out hereat in full, except as hereinafter provided. A copy of said agency rules herewith incorporated is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

Section II. The Stockpiling of bark bearing elmwood within the City limits of the City of Carlton shall be permitted during the period from September 15th through April 1 of any given year. Any such wood not utilized by April 1 of any year must then be removed and disposed of as provided by this ordinance and the regularions incorporated Thereby.

Section III. Where the provisions of this ordinance conflict or are inconsistent with any other ordinance of the City, the provisions of this ordinance shall supercede except in instances where one regulation is more restrictive than another in which case the more restrictive shall apply and control.

Section IV. Any person who shall violate any provisions of this ordinance shall be, upon conviction thereof, guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed \$100.00.

Section V. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its due passage and enactment and publication according to law.
