

ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 54 AND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 95 REGULATING THE CARLTON VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE NUMBER OF OFFICERS THEREOF:

The City Council of the City of Carlton does ordain as follows:

That Section 2, Ordinance No. 54 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 95 of the City of Carlton be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The Fire Department shall consist of twenty-five members, from which members a fire chief and two assistant fire chiefs and five captains shall be elected as hereinafter set forth and there shall also be a waiting list of five reserves, all of which members shall be elected by the department, subject to the approval of the City Council and all of whom shall be between 21 and 55 years of age, and shall be citizens and residents of the City. The fire chief and two assistant fire chiefs shall be elected for a term of 3 years after the first year. The first year the chief shall be elected for a term of three years, one assistant chief for a term of 2 years, and one assistant chief for a term of one year. The five captains shall be elected for a term of two years. The department shall elect a secretary-treasurer from the members, to hold office for one year."

This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after passage and publication.
