ORDINANCE NO. ~~108~~

An Ordinance Forbidding the Connection of Roof and Surface Water Drains to the Sanitary Sewer System and Providing a Penalty for Violation.

Be it Ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Carlton, as follows:

Section I: No roof or surface water drain shall be connected directly or indirectly to the sanitary sewer system of the Village.

Section II: All roof drains shall be discharged into a storm sewer system or at a distance of at least three feet from the walls of any house.


Section III: Within 30 days after the passage and publication of this ordinance any person, firm, or corporation having a roof or surface drain which now discharges directly or indirectly water into the sanitary sewer system shall disconnect the same and thereafter comply with the foregoing sections of this ordinance.

Section IV: To insure compliance with the provision of this ordinance the Village Council of the Village of Carlton may from time to time by resolution designate a person or persons who shall be authorized and given the authority at any reasonable hour to enter any building or premises for the purpose of inspecting the same to determine whether or not the owner of said premises is complying with the terms of this ordinance. Such inspection may be made at any reasonable hour and such inspector may do such acts as may reasonably be necessary to determine the facts with reference to any suspected violation.

Section V: Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon a conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00. Each week of continuous violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section VI: This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
