

ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES DURING CERTAIN PERIODS.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. I During the period from November 1 to March 31 of each year, no person, persons, firm or corporation shall park any motor vehicle on the streets, alleys, boulevards, sidewalks or public grounds within the corporate limits of said Village between the hours of three o'clock A.M. and six o'clock A.M. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Police to cause any such motor vehicle that is so parked between three o'clock A.M. and six o'clock A.M. to be removed to a public garage in said City, and such motor vehicle shall not be released until the fees for towing and storage of said vehicle are paid.
- Sec. II Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
