

ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATIONS, AND RATES COVERING THE SUPPLY OF WATER TO THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON AND ITS INHABITANTS AND ESTABLISHING SEWER RATES.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton does ordain as follows:

- Sec. I That residents of the Village of Carlton obtaining water from the Village shall pay for the same in accordance with the following monthly flat rates:
- (a) For residences with two inhabitants or less, the flat rate shall be \$2.00 per month.
 - (b) For residences with three inhabitants the rate shall be \$2.50 per month.
 - (c) For residences with four inhabitants the flat rate shall be \$3.00 per month.
 - (d) For residences with five inhabitants the flat rate shall be \$3.25 per month.
 - (e) For residences with six or more inhabitants the flat rate shall be \$3.50, which shall be the maximum rate.
- Sec. II That residents of the Village of Carlton utilizing the public sewer system of the Village of Carlton shall pay the following rates:
- (a) For residences with one inhabitant the rate will be \$1.00 per month.
 - (b) For residences with two or more inhabitants the rate will be \$1.50 per month.
- Sec. III That all churches within the Village of Carlton shall pay the minimum flat rate for water and sewer service of the Village.
- Sec. IV That the owner of residential property within the Village of Carlton shall henceforth be solely liable for the payments of the water and sewer rates established herein, notwithstanding occupancy of the residence by persons other than the owner thereof.
- Sec. V That commercial users of water from the Village of Carlton shall be metered, and meter rates for the payment of water furnished by the Village shall be as follows, to-wit:
- For the first two thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, Two and 00/100 Dollars (2.00)
 - For the next eight thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, fifty-five cents (55¢) per thousand gallons.
 - For the next ten thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, fifty cents (50¢) per Thousand gallons.
 - For the second twenty thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, forty-five cents (45¢) per thousand gallons.
 - For the third twenty thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, forty cents (40¢) per thousand gallons.
 - For the fourth twenty thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, thirty-five cents (35¢) per thousand gallons.

For the fifth twenty thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, thirty cents (30¢) per thousand gallons.

For the second one hundred thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, twenty-five (25¢) per thousand gallons.

For the next eight hundred thousand gallons, or fraction thereof, used bi-monthly, twenty-three (23¢) per thousand gallons.

For the second one million gallons, or fraction thereof, used per month sixteen cents (16¢) per thousand gallons, and for the third million gallons and everything additional thereto used per month, eleven (11¢) per thousand gallons.

Sec. VI That commercial users of the sewer system of the Village of Carlton shall pay bi-monthly to the Village a sum equal to 50% of the bi-monthly water meter rate payable as and for a sewer charge.

Sec. VII All bills incurred by residents of the Village of Carlton using water or sewer service of the Village in accordance with this Ordinance shall be paid to the Village by the owners of residences and commercial businesses in full on or before the 25th day of the month in which the bill is mailed. An additional charge shall be assessed on delinquent bills at the rate of \$1.00 per month, or any part thereof, of such delinquency; upon failure of the user to pay any bill and delinquency assessments in full within ninety (90) days from the due date, the service shall be immediately terminated by the Village. In the event of termination, service may be restored to the user only upon prior payment by the user or owner of the premises served, as the case may be, of all accrued charges in full plus the additional charge or assessment of \$15.00.

Sec. VIII All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. IX This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in accordance with law.
