

ORDINANCE NO. 83

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 64 and PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF COMMERCIAL GARBAGE COLLECTORS WITHIN THE VILLAGE AND FOR THE LICENSING OF NON-RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE TO DUMP REFUSE ON THE DUMP GROUND OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON.

- Sec. I Ordinance No. 64 entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing and Locating a Dump Ground for the Village of Carlton for the use of the Residents of the Village of Carlton" is hereby amended by striking "Section 3" thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "Section 3". Any person or persons, not residents of the Village of Carlton, who, for themselves or for others shall dump or cause to be dumped on said tract of land, any garbage, refuse, or material of any kind, unless he shall have purchased a Village dump permit licensing him to do so, as hereinafter provided, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs shall be committed to the county jail of Carlton County for not to exceed 90 days."
- Sec. II THE Village Clerk of the Village of Carlton is hereby authorized and directed to accept applications for and issued village dump permits licensing non-residents of the Village of Carlton to dump garbage or refuse upon the village dump ground. The license fee shall be \$3.00 per year, payable yearly in advance.
- Sec. III The Village Clerk of the Village of Carlton is hereby authorized and directed to accept and issue a village commercial garbage collection license authorizing the licensee to collect garbage, refuse, or material of any kind within the village limits and to dump the same upon the dump ground of the village. The license fee shall be \$50.00 per year, payable yearly in advance.
- Sec. IV Any person or persons who shall engage in the business of commercial garbage collection within the Village of Carlton from and after the passage and publication of this Ordinance, without first being licensed to do so as hereinabove provided, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs shall be committed to the county jail of Carlton County for not to exceed 90 days.
- Sec. V This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication
