

ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 53, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF".

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton does hereby ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 53 entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF", is hereby amended by to adding Section 3 the following:

Sub-heading 14a. On the westerly side of Second Street from Chestnut Street to Cedar Street.
