

ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND LOCATING A DUMP GROUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF
CARLTON FOR THE USE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON

- Sec. I A dump ground for the Village of Carlton is hereby established and located on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section One (1), Township Forty-eight (48) North of Range Seventeen (17) West of the 4th P.M. in Carlton County, Minnesota
- Sec. II Said dump ground shall be for the use of the residents of the Village of Carlton and for none others.
- Sec. III Any person or persons, not residents of the Village of Carlton, who, for themselves or for others, shall dump or cause to be dumped on said tract of land, any garbage, refuse or material of any kind shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$50.00 and costs of prosecution and in default of the payment of such fine and costs shall be committed to the county jail of Carlton County for not to exceed 60 days.
- Sec. IV This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
