

ORDINANCE NO. 67

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 50 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE SALE OF NON-INTOXICATING MALT LIQUORS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF"

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton does ordain as follows:

- Sec. I That Section 2 be amended by adding thereto an additional paragraph to be known as paragraph (f) and read as follows: Exclusive Liquor Store means an establishment exclusively for the sale of non-intoxicating liquor, cigars, cigarettes, all forms of tobacco and soft drinks at retail, either "on sale" or "off sale" or both. It shall be under control of an individual owner or manager.
- Sec. II That Section 6 be amended to read as follows: "On Sale" licenses shall be granted only to drug stores, restaurants, hotels, bona fide clubs and exclusive liquor stores and no manufacturer of non-intoxicating malt liquor shall have any ownership in whole or in part, directly or indirectly in the business of any licensee holding an "On Sale" license.
- Sec. III All Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance in whole or part are hereby repealed.
- Sec. IV This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
