

ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE INSTALLING OF PHONOGRAPHS, FOR USE BY THE PUBLIC, IN PUBLIC PLACES OF BUSINESS IN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON

The Village Council of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. I It shall be unlawful for any person to install a phonograph, for use by the public in any public place of business in the Village of Carlton, without first having obtained a permit therefore from the Village Council.
- Sec. II Any owner of a phonograph who shall install or permit to be installed a phonograph in a public place of business for use by the public shall first pay to the Village Treasurer of said Village an annual license fee of \$5.00 for each phonograph.
- Sec. III No amplifiers shall be used either on the inside or outside of such place of business.
- Sec. IV Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than \$25.00 and costs or by imprisonment in the county jail for not to exceed 30 days.
- Sec. V This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
