

ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 68 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION"

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do hereby ordain as follows:

Sec. I Ordinance No. 68 entitled, "An ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION" is hereby amended striking therefrom Section 7 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

✓ "Section 7. Hours of Operation. The sale of intoxicating liquor shall be permitted at all times, except as herein prohibited. No sale of intoxicating liquor shall be made after 1:00 A.M. on Sunday nor between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M. on any Memorial Day, nor between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. on any Election day in the Village. No "on sale" shall be made between the hours of 1:00^{PM} and 8:00 A.M. on any week day. No "off sale" shall be made before 8:00 A.M. or after 10:00 P.M. on any day. No "offsale" shall be made on New Year's Day, January 1; Memorial Day, May 30; Independence Day, July 4; Thanksgiving Day; or Christmas Day, December 25, nor after 8:00 P.M. on December 24."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
