

ORDINANCE NO. 63

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A CIVILIAN DEFENSE COUNCIL IN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON DURING WAR EMERGENCIES.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

Sec. I There shall be established in the Village of Carlton a Civilian Defense Council the members of which shall be appointed by the President of the Village Council. This Civilian Defense Council shall organize by electing one of its member Chairman.

Durles of Civil Defense Council
Sec. II The Civilian Defense Council as established in the ^{City}Village of Carlton shall have authority to declare a Blackout period when in their opinion it is deemed necessary for the welfare of the ^{City}Village, to regulate the sounding of air raid alarms, to regulate the conduct of all persons during an air raid blackout, and to regulate all other matters which are required to protect public safety, health, and welfare in the war emergency. All regulations adopted by the Civilian Defense Council shall be posted on the bulletin board of the ^{City}Village Hall, The ^{City}Village Council may, at any time, by resolution rescind any such regulations.

Carlton obligation
Sec. III No person during a blackout period shall maintain any illumination or permit any illumination under his control to be maintained at any place within the ^{City}Village of Carlton unless an exemption has been allowed by the Civilian Defense Council.

Vehicle regulation
Sec. IV Except for emergency vehicles as defined in the Minnesota highway traffic regulation act, no vehicle shall be moved on the streets of the village during a blackout period unless directed to be moved by a regular or auxiliary police officer, fireman, or air raid warden.

Chief Air Raid Warden
Sec. V The Chairman of the Civilian Defense Council shall have authority to appoint a Chief Air Raid Warden for the village who in turn may call for and accept as many volunteer air raid wardens as he deems necessary. During such term of service, such air raid wardens shall have special police powers to enforce such rules and regulations as are established by this ordinance and by the Civilian Defense Council. All volunteer air raid wardens shall serve without compensation.

Mayor
Extra Police
Sec. VI The ~~President of the Village Council~~ ^{Mayor} shall have the authority to appoint as many volunteer auxiliary police officers as he deems necessary for the purpose of enforcing the rules and regulations of the Civilian Defense Council and of this ordinance. Such volunteer auxiliary police officers shall service without compensation.

Fines & Imprisonment
Sec. VII Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance or of any regulation adopted by the Civilian Defense Council shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days in the county jail.

WHEN EFFECTIVE
Sec. VIII This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
