

ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING RESTAURANTS, CAFES, LUNCH ROOMS AND ANY AND ALL PERSONS SERVING FOOD AND/OR DRINKS TO THE PUBLIC TO HAVE IN THEIR PLACE OF BUSINESS A WASH ROOM CONTAINING A WATER CLOSET AND A LAVATORY WITH RUNNING WATER.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. I All restaurants, cafes, lunch rooms and any and all persons furnishing food and/or drinks to the public shall have in their place of business a wash room containing a water closet and a lavatory with running water.
- Sec. II Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 and in default of the payment of such fine is imprisoned in the county jail for not to exceed 60 days.
- Sec. III This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
