

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE TO PURCHASE THE CEMETARY KNOWN AS HILLSIDE CEMETARY

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

*The Purchase of.*  
Sec. I That the <sup>City</sup>Village of Carlton purchase for the sum of \$600.00 the following described property to be used as a <sup>City</sup>Village Cemetary, to wit:

All of the unsold lots and out lots together with the streets and alleys and public highways, subject to the use of the public ~~here-~~  
~~in~~ in the Hillside Cemetery, formerly Carlton Cemetary according to the Plat thereof; Also all of the Addition to Carlton Cemetary, not platted and four and 35-100 acres described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section Seven (7) Township Forty Eight (48) North of Range Sixteen (16) West and following the south line of said Section in an easterly direction a distance of 1115.5 feet to the place of beginning of the land herein described, thence Northeasterly at an angle of 11° 14' east, 886.1 feet following the west boundary of the Carlton Cemetary (Now Hillside Cemetary), Thence Southwesterly a distance 998 feet to the south line of said section 7, Thence east on said section line a distance of 435 feet to the place of beginning. All of the above being the land owned by Cordelia Ayer Paine in the Southwest Quarter of Section Seven (7) Township Forty Eight (48) North of Range Sixteen (16) West in Carlton County, Minnesota, generally known as Hillside Cemetary property and same is conveyed for cemetary purposes.

Sec. II That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
