

ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH AND THE COLLECTION THEREOF.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton does ordain:

- Sec. I It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to fail to dispose of garbage and rubbish which may be or may accumulate upon property owned or occupied by such person, firm, or corporation, at least as often as provided in Section II hereof.
- Sec. II All garbage and rubbish located on any property owned or occupied by any person, firm, or corporation, shall be removed from said property at least and not less than once every week.
- Sec. III The word "garbage" as used herein shall include only organic refuse resulting from the preparation of food and decayed and spoiled food from any source.  
The word "rubbish" as used herein shall include all inorganic refuse matter such as tin cans, glass, paper, sweepings and ashes.
- Sec. IV Every householder or occupant of any dwelling house, boarding house, restaurant or any place of business having garbage to dispose of, who does not otherwise provide for the disposal of such garbage in a sanitary manner and in accordance with Section II hereof, shall provide himself with one or more flytight, metal cans sufficient to receive all garbage and rubbish which may accumulate between the time of collection or disposal. Each can shall have a capacity of not to exceed thirty-three (33) gallons and shall be provided with a bail or handles and a tight fitting cover. All such cans shall at all times be kept clean and in a good state of repair.
- Sec. V All garbage must and shall be wrapped in paper when placed in the aforementioned containers provided and referred to in Section IV and no liquids shall be placed in said metal cans unless enclosed in a closed container.
- Sec. VI Garbage and rubbish cans shall be kept at or near the back door of the building, using the same, or in the rear of the property if there is an alley, and accessible for collection at all reasonable times.
- Sec. VII It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to expose garbage or rubbish or other offensive matter, so that the same shall cause the premises whereon it may be located, to become unclean, unhealthy or offensive.
- Sec. VIII It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to burn or dispose of any garbage or rubbish within the corporate limits of the Village of Carlton.
- Sec. IX Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than Five and no-100ths (\$5.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred and no-100ths (\$100.00) Dollars, or imprisonment for not less than three (3) days nor more than sixty (60) days.
- Sec. X This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.
