

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 23 OF ORDINANCE NO. 50, WHICH SAID ORDINANCE NO. 50 IS AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE SALE OF NON-INTOXICATING MALT LIQUORS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton does Ordain:

Sec. I Section 23 of Ordinance no. 50 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 23 No more than six (6) "On Sale" licenses and no more than six (6) "Off Sale" licenses shall be issued in any one license year.

Sec. II All ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance in whole or part are hereby repealed.

Sec. III This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
