

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR LICENSE TO SELL NON-INTOXICATING MALT LIQUORS IN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

Sec. I It shall be unlawful for any person, persons or corporation to sell non-intoxicating malt liquors in the Village of Carlton at retail or wholesale without first having obtained a license therefore as hereinafter provided.

Sec. II There shall be two kinds of licenses, viz; "On Sale" licenses and "Off Sale" licenses.

"On Sale" licenses shall permit the licensee to sell such non-intoxicating malt liquor for consumption on the licensed premises and the license fee therefore shall be Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars per annum. And such "On Sale" license shall be issued only to drug stores, restaurants, hotels and Bona Fide Clubs.

"Off Sale" licenses shall permit the licensee to sell such non-intoxicating malt beverages in original packages for consumption off the licenses premises and the license fee therefore shall be Five (\$5.00) Dollars per annum, except for wholesalers of such non-intoxicating malt liquors, other than manufactures thereof and the license fee for such wholesalers shall be Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

Sec. III Licenses hereunder shall be issued only to persons who are citizens of the United State and who are of good moral character and reputation and over the age of twenty one years.

Sec. IV It shall be unlawful to sell such liquor to any person under the age of 21 years.

Sec. V Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not to exceed thirty days.

Sec. VI The Village Council shall have the right to revoke any license issued hereunder on proper cause shown and a violation of the Eighteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the U.S. or of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a proper cause.

Sec. VII All licenses issued hereunder shall terminate on the first day of April of each year.

Sec. VIII All ordinance inconsistent with this ordinance in whole or in part are hereby repealed.

Sec. IX This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
