

ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING PERMISSION TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY, A CORPORATION ORGANIZED AND DOING BUSINESS UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF INDIANA, TO ERECT AND MAINTAIN ON THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED BELOW, WAREHOUSE, TANKS AND OTHER BUILDINGS NECESSARY FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS BUSINESS, AND TO STORE THEREIN ILLUMINATING OILS, NAPHTHA, GASOLINE OR ANY OTHER MINERAL OILS OR FLUIDS, THE PRODUCTS OF PETROLEUM, IN QUANTITIES SUFFICIENT TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF ITS BUSINESS.

Be it ordained by the Village Council of the Incorporated Village of Carlton in the County of Carlton, State of Minnesota.

Sec. 1 That permission and authority is hereby given and granted to Standard Oil Company, a corporation organized and doing business under, and by virtue of the laws of the State of Indiana, to construct and maintain on the following described property within the limits of the Incorporated Village of Carlton County of Carlton and State of Minnesota to wit: Commencing at a point 130' due north of Chestnut Street extended, said point being due north of North 1st St. on the west leg of Northern Pacific Railroad Wye, thence due west to a point on the Westerly limits of said RR R/W thence along said RR R/W in a SWly direction to the Northerly limits of Chestnut street extended, thence easterly along said Chestnut St. to a point on the Westerly leg of said RR Wye, thence along said track forming westerly leg of RR WYE in a northerly direction to the point of beginning.

Warehouse, tanks and other buildings necessary for its business, and to store therein illuminating oils, coal oils, naphtha, gasoline, or any other mineral oils or fluids, the products of petroleum in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of said Company's business.

Sec. II Ordinance No. 40 and all ordinance and parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. III This ordinance shall be in force and effect on and after its passage and publication and acceptance in writing by said Standard Oil Company.
