

ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING PERMISSION TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY, A CORPORATION ORGANIZED AND DOING BUSINESS UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF INDIANA, TO ERECT AND MAINTAIN ON THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED BELOW, WAREHOUSE, TANKS AND OTHER BUILDINGS NECESSARY FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS BUSINESS, AND TO STORE THEREIN ILLUMINATING OILS, NAPHTHA, GASOLINE OR ANY OTHER MINERAL OILS OR FLUIDS, THE PRODUCTS OF PETROLEUM, IN QUANTITIES SUFFICIENT TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF ITS BUSINESS.

B e it ordained by the Village Council of the Incorporated Village of Carlton in the County of Carlton, State of Minnesota.

Sec. 1 That permission and authority is hereby given and granted to Standard Oil Company, a corporation organized and doing business under, and by virtue of the laws of the State of Indiana, to construct and maintain on the following described property within the limits of the Incorporated Village of Carlton, County of Carlton and State of Minnesota to wit: Lots 1-2-3 Block A of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's plat of its right of way, located at the corner of North and Third Streets.

Warehouse, tanks and other buildings necessary for its business, and to store therein illyminating oils, coal oils, naphtha, gasoline, or any other mineral oils or fluids, the products of petroleum in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of said Company's business.

Sec. 2 All ordinance and parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3 This ordinance shall be in force and effect on and after its passage and publication and acceptance in writing by said Standard Oil Company.
