

ORDINANCE NO 26

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT FAST DRIVING UPON THE STREETS OF THE VILLAGE OF  
CARLTON

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1 It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ride or drive any team, horse or vehicle, or to propel or operate any automobile or motor vehicle of any description upon the streets of the Village of Carlton at a greater speed than eight miles per hour.
- Sec. 2 Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed one hundred dollars or not to exceed ninety days in the County Jail.
- Sec. 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
