

ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRAIN THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS AND TO AUTHORIZE THEIR DESTRUCTION WHEN FOUND UNMUZZLED.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person residing or being in the Village of Carlton to allow any dog, bitch or any animal of the dog kind to run at large in said village unless said animal is safely and securely muzzled.
- Sec. 2 Every such dog, or bitch found running at large contrary to the provisions of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and the Village Marshal is authorized to destroy such animals so unlawfully running at large, in a summary manner.
- Sec. 3 This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.
