

ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL MONEYS BELONGING TO THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON TO BE KEPT IN THE FUNDS TO WHICH THEY BELONG AND REQUIRING THAT NO ORDERS SHALL BE ISSUED EXCEPT FOR IMMEDIATE CASH PAYMENT.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1 All moneys belonging to the Village of Carlton shall be placed in the respective funds to which they belong and shall be drawn therefrom only for the purpose for which levied or collected; except that by action of the Village Council any surplus in any fund may be transferred to the general fund, or from the general fund to supply any deficiency in any other fund.
- Sec. 2 Hereafter no Village order shall be drawn except for immediate cash payment.
- Sec. 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication.
