

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BLOWING OUT OF BOILERS

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1 It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to blow out the boiler or boilers of any locomotive engine within the limits of the Village of Carlton.
- Sec. 2 Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not exceeding ninety days.
- Sec. 3 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
