

ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND REGULATE A BOARD OF HEALTH IN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

BOAH

Sec. 1
Establishment + Membership

There is hereby established in the ^{City}Village of Carlton a Board of Health to be composed of three citizens of said Village, one of whom shall be a practicing physician and who shall be designated as Health Officer. He shall be elected by the ^{City}Village Council and shall hold office for three years. The other two members of the Board of Health shall be elected annually by the ^{City}Village Council and all members shall hold their office until their successors are elected and qualified unless sooner removed by said Council. The ^{City}Village Council shall have power to fill a vacancy at any meeting.

Sec. 2
Compensation

The Health Officer and members of the Board of Health shall receive such compensation as the Council may determine and before entering upon the duties of their office shall take the usual oath of office.

Sec. 3
Power of BOAH

The Board of Health shall exercise a general supervision over the Health of the ^{City}Village, with full power to take all steps and use all measures necessary to promote the cleanliness and sanitary conditions thereof to prevent the introduction into the ^{City}village of malignant, contagious or infectious diseases, and to remove, or otherwise take care of any person attacked by such disease, and to adopt, in reference to such persons, any regulations, restrictions or measures deemed advisable, and to establish rules for the government of the ^{City}Village pest house and quarantines.

Sec. 4
Approval

The Health Officer shall give the Board of Health and the ^{City}Village Council all such professional advice and information as they may require with a view to the preservation of the public health and whenever such Health Officer shall hear or learn of any malignant, contagious or pestilential disease he shall investigate the same and adopt measures to arrest its progress.

Sec. 5
Duty of H.O.

It shall be the further duty of the Health Officer to enforce all of the laws of the state and the ordinance of the ^{City}Village in relation to the sanitary regulations of the ^{City}Village and cause all nuisances to be abated with reasonable promptness; and for the purpose of carrying out the foregoing requirements he shall be permitted at all times to enter into any house, store, stable, or other building and with the approval of the Board of Health he shall cause the floors to be raised, if deemed necessary in order to make a thorough examination of the cellars, vaults, sinks, or drains, and cause all privies and water closets to be cleaned and kept in good condition, and cause all dead animals and other nauseous or unwholesome things or substances to be buried or removed or disposed of as the said Health Officer may direct.

Sec. 6
Power of H.O.

In order to carry out the provisions of the foregoing section it shall be the duty of the Health Officer to serve or cause to be served, a notice in writing upon the owner, occupant or agent of any lot, building or premises in or upon which any nuisance may be found who may be the owner or cause of any such nuisance, requiring them to abate the same in such manner as he shall prescribe and within the time named in such notice; provided that it shall not be necessary in any case for the Health Officer to specify in his notice the manner in which any nuisance shall be abated, unless he shall deem it advisable so to do; and such notice may be given by any officer or person who may be directed or deputed to give or make the same, and if such owner, occupant or agent shall neglect or refuse to comply with the requirements of such order within the time specified they shall be subject to the penalty hereinafter prescribed and it shall be the duty of said Health Officer to proceed at once, upon the expiration of the time specified in said notice, to cause such nuisance to be abated, and provided further, that whenever the owner, occupant

or agent of the premises, in or upon which any nuisance may be found, is unknown or cannot be found, the said Health Officer shall proceed to abate the same without notice, and in either case the expense of such abatement shall be collected from the person or persons who may have created, continued or suffered such nuisance to exist or if not paid, charged and assessed against the property where and upon which such nuisance does or has existed or been as hereinafter provided.

Duty of Board

Said Board of Health shall make such rules and regulations for the government of quarantines of health in said Village as from time to time they may deem necessary or advisable, and they shall have power to make and enforce such regulations as may be necessary for the proper conducting and management thereof; and it shall be the duty of all persons in quarantine and all agents, officers policemen or others employed by the Village in and about said quarantine stations or places to carry out and obey the same.

Sec. VIII

Duty of all members

It shall be the duty of the members of the Board of Health to make a circuit of observation as often as deemed necessary to every part of the Village and its environs and surroundings, and if anything is found which from its location or from any collateral circumstances may be deemed the cause of disease and in all cases where they shall find the existence of any agent, the presence of which will prove dangerous to the health of the Village, they shall take immediate steps to abate the same, and if there is no ordinance to correct the evil, they shall report the same to the Village Council with their opinion of the necessity of extraordinary or particular action. Said Board of Health shall at any time they deem it necessary cooperate with the Boards of Health of adjoining towns or Villages in matters pertaining to the general health of the Village.

The Health Officer shall cause notice to be placed on or near any house in which there is a person affected or sick with any contagious disease, upon which notice shall be written or printed the name of such disease and no person or persons shall remove or deface said notice without permission from the Health Officer.

Burial

The burial of any person who may die of any contagious disease shall be under the direction of the Health Officer, and immediately a thorough disinfection shall be made of the place where such death occurred.

Sec. XI

General

If any person within the limits of the Village of Carlton shall permit or suffer on his or her or their premises or on the premises of which he, she or they may be the agent, or occupants, any nuisance, either by exercising any unwholesome or offensive trade, calling or business, or by having or suffering or permitting any building, outhouse, sewer, sink drain, or any putrid carcass or any unwholesome substance or thing whatever to be or remain on the premises of which he, she or they shall be the agent, owners, or occupants and by offensive or ill stench or otherwise said premises, or any of them shall become offensive, hurtful or dangerous to the neighborhood, it shall be the duty of the Health Officer to give notice to such person or persons to remove such nuisance forthwith, and if the owner, agent or occupant of said premises on which such nuisance shall be situated, shall neglect or refuse to remove or abate the same for the space of twenty four hours after such notice shall have been given he, she or they shall be subject to a fine as hereinafter provided.

Expenses

If any person or persons shall after notice as aforesaid permit any such nuisance to remain, which shall be manifestly dangerous hurtful or improper it shall be lawful for the Board of Health to remove and abate such nuisance, either by removing any putrid matter or by draining the premises or by filling them up under the direction of the Health Officer and the costs and expenses thereof shall be rendered to the Village Council and be paid in the first instance by said council from the Village treasury, and the Village Recorder directed and required by said Village Council to return the same with a full description of the property so

benefitted, together with the name of the owner or supposed owner to the County Auditor, who shall charge the same up against the said property as other assessments for improvements are made and collect the same as taxes together with other taxes against said property.

Sec. XIII
Cess Pools
Privies &
Waterclosets

All Cess pools and privies and waterclosets, not properly constructed and ventilated according to the provisions of law and the Rules of the Board of Health, all offensive odors or matter, kept or allowed to exist together with all offenses which are known to the Common Law and the Statues of Minnesota as nuisances may in case the same exist within the Village of Carlton be treated as such and be proceeded against as provided in this ordinance, or in accordance with any other law which will the officer trying the same jurisdiction.

Organic
Matter

No manure, garbage, offal or any vegetable or animal matter or nauseous substance detrimental to health shall be dumped or deposited within the limits of the Village of Carlton at any place ~~except~~ at such place or places as are designated by the Board of Health.

C.R.F.M.
Obligation

Each and Every person shall obey such regulation and every order of the Board of Health that is or may be made for carrying into effect any of the foregoing sections or powers or any law of this state or otherwise, whether issued directly by the Board or promulgated by the Health Officer as if the same had been inserted herein at length.

Sec. XVI
Scavengers

The Board of Health shall have control of the scavenger and all scavenger work shall be done under the supervision and direction of the Board of Health.

Fines &
Arrests

Any person who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with or who resists any of the provisions of this ordinance or refuses or neglects to obey any of the rules, orders or sanitary regulations of the Board of Health or who neglects, omit or refuses to comply with or who resists any officer or order or special regulation of said Board of Health Officer shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) or be imprisoned in the County Jail for not to exceed ninety days, together with costs of prosecution.
