

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ACT REGULATING THE KEEPING OPEN OF RAILROAD CROSSINGS IN THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of said Village do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1           It shall be unlawful for any person, company or corporation operating any railway line in said Village, to obstruct the crossing of the Streets of said Village or any of them, by allowing any car or cars or coach or coaches or Locomotives or any of them to remain on any of the crossings of any of said streets, for a longer time than FIVE minutes.
- Sec. 2           Any person or persons in charge of or in any manner connected with or responsible for any car or cars or coach or coaches or locomotive or locomotives which shall obstruct any of the said street crossings within said Village limits for a longer time than FIVE minutes shall upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace in and for said Village be punished by a fine of not less than One Dollar nor more than One Hundred Dollars, with costs of suit and in default of the payment of said fine and costs the person so convicted shall be committed to the Watch House or Jail of said Village or the County Jail of said County until such fine and costs are fully paid, but not to exceed twenty days.
- Sec. 3           Old ordinance number 7 entitled "An ordinance relating to Railroad Crossings" is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 4           This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
