

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ACT RESTRAINING ENGINEERS AND OTHERS FROM BLOWING LOCOMOTIVE WHISTLES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLTON, CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, EXCEPTING AT RAILROAD CROSSINGS.

The Village Council of the Village of Carlton do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1 It shall be unlawful for any person, company or corporation operating any railway line in said Village, to blow or cause to be blown any Locomotive whistle within the corporate limits of said Village, excepting at regular Railroad crossings.
- Sec. 2 Any person or persons in charge of or in any manner connected with or responsible for any Locomotive Engine, who shall blow or cause to be blown the whistle of said Locomotive within the corporate limits of said Village, excepting at Railroad crossings, shall upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace in and for said Village, be punished by a fine of not less than One Dollar nor more than Twenty Five Dollars, and the costs of suit, and in default of payment of said fine and costs, the person so convicted shall be committed to the Watch House or Jail of said Village or the County Jail of said County until such fine and costs are fully paid but not to exceed ten days.
- Sec. 3 This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
