CARLTON COUNTY RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY

NO BUSINESS RECYCLABLES

PLASTICS: bottles, jars, jugs, and tubs

Rinse, remove caps Flatten if possible

ALUMINUM CANS

Rinse Flatten

TIN AND METAL CANS

Rinse

Flatten if possible

GLASS JARS AND BOTTLES

Rinse, remove caps and rings Separate clear, brown, and green glass **NO** light bulbs, mirrors, ceramic or broken glass

MAGAZINES

Empty into correct bins

No books

OFFICE PAPER and NEWSPAPER

Empty into correct bins

Newspaper, office, computer, colored paper; envelopes, junk mail, and glossy inserts.

NO carbon paper, gift wrap, tissue paper, plastic wrapping, bound books or spiral notebooks.

SHREDDED PAPER

MUST BE BAGGED. Place in office paper/ newspaper bin.

CARDBOARD & BOXBOARD

MUST BE FLATTENED AND CLEAN.

Corrugated Cardboard

Boxboard (cereal, pasta, cracker boxes, etc.)

Brown paper bags and egg cartons

NO pizza boxes, wax boxes, foil, plastic laminated boxes, or milk cartons.

Please respect the unstaffed sheds. Do not dispose of garbage. All recyclables must be placed in their proper containers. Do not leave bags of unsorted recyclables.

PLASTICS

Many plastics are **not recyclable** even though they are coded with a number:

5-gallon pails, toys, flower pots, plastic bags, plastic wrap, Styrofoam, Tupperware, plastic cups, plates and utensils are NOT accepted at the recycling centers.
