Ashley and Derek reviewed drawings for water treatment plant and infrastructure upgrades. The water meter pit will be an alternate bid. The water treatment plant computer system will be set up to allow for communication with the meter pit when it would be installed. The plans will now go through Quality Control Review by Donohue Staff.

RD has not reviewed the Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) yet. The EDU count has been lowered.

Plans will be submitted to Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) by March 23, 2018 to get them Certified.

Kitty Bureau met with Senator Nolan's representative. Senator Nolan is in favor of the project and will help in any way he can.

Next Steps: Have meetings with Carlton County, Minnesota Power and Fond du Lac to keep them up to date on the project.
