

Contractors must provide proof that they are in compliance with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Rule prior to pulling a permit to work on pre-1978 residential properties or child-occupied facilities with known or presumed lead-based paint. Contracting firms are required to become EPA Lead Certified Renovation firms and are required to have at least one Certified Renovator assigned to each renovation project.
