

Archery Hunting Requirements:

Completed Archery Deer Hunting Application.

Proficiency Certificate from authorized facility (*issued within 12 months of hunting season*). In lieu of proficiency testing individuals may submit their score card from a 3D course.

Clear photocopy of valid archery license issued by the appropriate authority (DNR).

Clear photocopy of valid state-issued ID or driver's license.

The applicant may use a crossbow as long as the requirements set forth by the MN DNR are met.

Address or PID (Parcel Identification Number) of land to be hunted. *PID number can be obtained from Carlton County GIS site.*

Signed approval from property owners.

Type of bow & arrow to be used.

One article of blaze orange must be worn (ie – vest/hat)
